- We encourage customers to visit during non-peak hours**
- We request masks be worn by those able to without adverse health impacts.**

- Enter the tree lot first to select your tree. Once you've selected a tree payment is made inside the shop. Only one family inside the shop at a time, please. While you're checking out we will load your tree on/in your vehicle for you.**
- Sanitation Stations are available at the tree lot and inside the shop. Please make frequent use of them—especially after petting animals.**
- We reserve the right to deny service to anyone displaying signs of illness or not following farm guidelines.**

- **Please maintain social distancing.**
- **Payment is made at the tent. Please maintain a 6 foot distance when standing in line for checkout.**
- **Sanitation Stations are available at the tent and around the patch. Please make frequent use of them—especially after petting animals.**
- **We reserve the right to deny service to anyone displaying signs of illness or not following farm guidelines.**
